The University of Michigan Autism and Communication Disorders Center (UMACC) has two designated funds designed to provide financial assistance to individuals with autistic spectrum disorders and their families, who are unable to afford diagnostic evaluations and services.

## Erin's fund

The University of Michigan Autism and Communication Disorders Center (UMACC) has established a fund, in memory of Erin Tierney, to provide scholarships for UMACC social group participants, who would not otherwise be able to afford the groups and to support social group activities and events. Erin was a talented University of Michigan student, who was a valued member of the UMACC research team and a dedicated peer mentor for the participants in the social group for adults with Autistic Spectrum Disorders.

## Family Assistance Fund

The University of Michigan Autism and Communication Disorders Center (UMACC) has a designated fund, for families who are unable to afford evaluation and service fees because they do not have insurance or their insurance does not cover our services. Fees are reduced based on the financial needs of the family, which is determined on a case-by-case basis.
